Abstract Submission Guidelines

Submit your research abstract for consideration

1. Participants are invited to submit an abstract by **16th May 2014** for poster presentation and 31st March 2014 for oral presentation by no later than 11:59 pm central European time (GMT +1).
2. All abstracts have to be submitted electronically.
3. When submitting an abstract, please follow the guidelines found on the template provided [here](#). The abstract should be written using the one page format.
4. Once this document is complete, it should be uploaded to the irt2014.pl website in accordance with the instructions provided online.
5. The Presenting Author should be the primary contact or Corresponding Author.
6. No changes can be made to abstract content or authors after the submission deadline. Exceptions may be made for special cases where requests are received in writing.
7. Each Presenting Author may submit a maximum of two abstracts, but may be included as co-author on other additional abstracts.
8. After submitting an abstract the submitting author will be receive the identification number of the abstract that should be used in case of modifications.
9. Authors willing to participate in the *Wiley Current Protocols Methods Prize* competition should tickle the appropriate box when submitting the abstract. Authors should be ready to prepare the manuscript for publication in *Current Protocols in Nucleic Acid Chemistry*.
10. The organizing committee will select 15 of the abstracts submitted for oral presentation and invite the authors to present their research. The abstracts submitted for poster presentation might also be considered by the organizing committee for oral presentation.
11. The posters presented by young researchers will be a subject of evaluation by the IS3NA Poster & Travel Award Committee during the poster sessions of the meeting to name winners in the competition for 'IS3NA A. Holy IRT Poster Awards' 12 awards in honor of Professor Antonín Holý will be granted. Authors willing to participate in this competition should tickle the appropriate box when submitting the abstract.
12. To submit abstracts online, the presenting author must register for the XXI IRT event.
13. Faxed or mailed abstracts are NOT acceptable.
14. Abstracts as e-mail attachments will be accepted from registered delegates in case of technical problems. Such abstracts should be sent to the secretariat, indicating oral or poster, and indicating category.
15. Authors will be notified after evaluation and approval by the committee. Notification of acceptance or rejection and all future correspondence will be emailed to the presenter by 31st May 2014.
16. All accepted abstracts will be published in the electronic program book (available only online).
